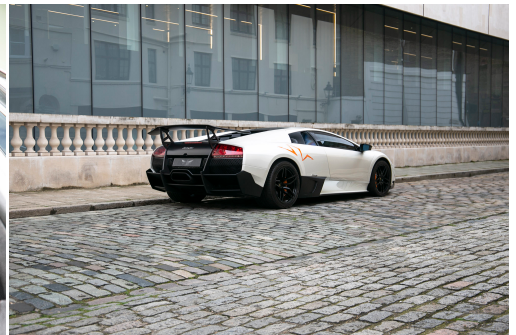

A celebration of raw, unfiltered performance, this **Murciélago LP670-4 Super Veloce** is one of just **350 units** built worldwide between **2009 and 2010**, and one of very few **right-hand-drive** examples. Finished in rare **Balloon White**. The **SV** (*Super Veloce*) is the most hardcore, lightweight, and track-focused Murciélago, powered by a **6.5L naturally aspirated V12** producing **670 PS**, paired with **E-Gear** and aggressive carbon aero. The name **Murciélago** is Spanish for “bat” comes from a legendary bull spared after surviving 24 sword strikes. It’s a fitting name for what is widely regarded as the **last true raging bull**, built before Audi’s full technological influence took hold. A raw, analog icon in its final and most thrilling form.
